## Tournament Rules Entry Requirements

Proposed Format (Tournament Director Reserves the Right to Change Tournament Format without Notice)

Check-in is from 8:00-8:30AM. There will be a coaches meeting at 8:45. Bowling will start at 9:00 AM.

All teams will participate in a 4-game qualifier. All four games will be bowled on the same pair.

All teams will advance onto the next level of the tournament where teams will compete in group pool play. Prior to advancing to pool play, all teams must trim their rosters down to a maximum of 8 players. These are the only 8 bowlers that can be used for the rest of the day.

Teams will be seeded into 3 groups based on the number of teams participating in the tournament. Each team will bowl a 2 game match against each team in its group. The goal of the 2-game match is to outscore your opponent over the 2 games (i.e. your team can get outscored by 23 pins the first game, but if your team wins the second game by 24 pins your team

wins the match.) Each match will be worth 4 points, the match winner will receive 4 points, and if there is a tie both teams will receive 2 points.

The two teams with the highest number of points from each group will advance to the single elimination championship bracket. (Two wild card teams will also advance to the championship bracket. These two teams will be decided out of the three teams that finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in their respective pool, and the 2 teams with the most pin-fall in pool play will advance to the championship bracket as the wild card teams, with the team with the most pin-fall getting the 1<sup>st</sup> wild card and the other team getting the 2<sup>nd</sup> wild card.) The championship bracket will use the same 2-game match format, and there will be a consolation bracket along with the championship bracket. The teams not qualifying for the championship bracket will be done for the day. In case of a tie in pool play, tiebreakers will be the following: 1<sup>st</sup> – results of head to head competition; 2<sup>nd</sup> – total pins knocked down in pool play; 3<sup>rd</sup> – highest gamed bowled during pool play; 4<sup>th</sup> – 2<sup>nd</sup> highest game bowled in pool play.

### **Awards**

The team that finishes in 1<sup>st</sup> place will receive a championship team plaque and medals for each of the bowlers on the team.

The teams finishing in 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place will also receive a plaque for the team, along with medals for each of the individuals on the team.

### **Rules**

This tournament will be governed by the rules of Minnesota High School Bowling (MHSB) and the general rules of bowling. A current copy of the current MHSB rules are on file with the tournament director.

### **Scoring Corrections**

If both coaches agree that a scoring change needs to be made, and they agree what that change is, then one of the coaches or players can make the change. If there is a dispute then the tournament director should be contacted.

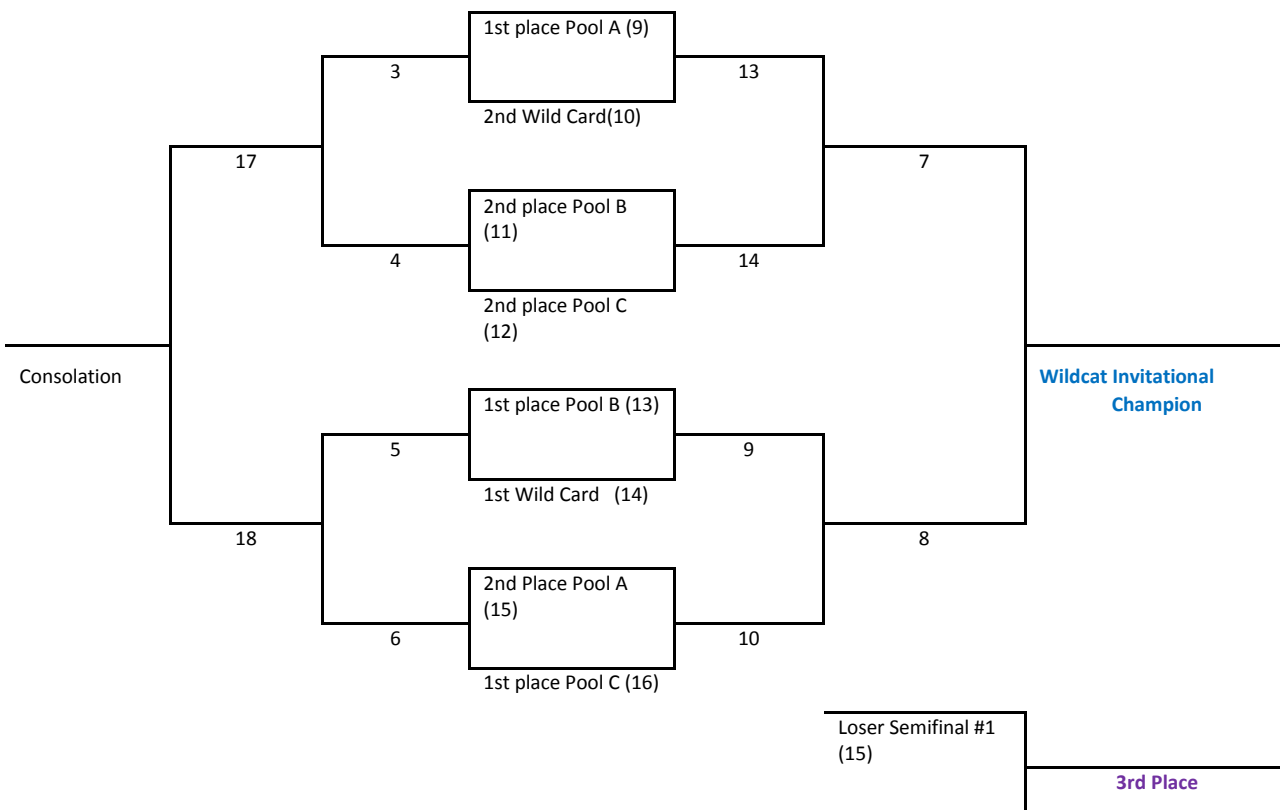
