General Rules

Payout is based on number of entries. Prize winnings will be placed on deposit with USBC SMART.

First place will receive a \$250 Scholarship, based on 150 entries as noted above.

Handicap is established as follows:

- Handicap score is based on 200. Participants will receive 80% of the difference between their average and 200. (Ex.: $200 - 155$ [avg] = $45 \times .80 = 36$ pins handicap per game)
- If the current year's average, as of 1 week before the date of the tournament, is not 10 pins higher than the last year's average on record with USBC, we will use the USBC average. If it is, then the current year's average will be used. This follows the normal 10 pin ruling for all tournaments.
- Averages can be verified by bringing in a recent copy of your junior league standings sheet
- Tournament Director reserves the right to rerate or refuse any tournament participant.

This gives everyone a fair chance no matter the age or ability.

- All USBC rules will apply.

Format:

Bowl 3 games on one pair of lanes. No more than four (4) bowlers per lane. Tournament entries close the day of the tournament with the last squad. Walk-ins encouraged.

Eligibility to bowl:

- Each squad entry requires 1 DVD or Video Game to bowl. All tournament entries will be free as long as you bring a DVD or Video Game. They must be in a gently used condition.
 - (DVD, Wii, DS, PS2, PS3 PSP, Xbox or Xbox 360 game)
 - Those wanting to bowl without a game to donate will be required to pay \$5.00 per entry (squad).

Score Corrections:

- All score corrections must be done by a Tournament Official to be accepted. Scored corrections by other than a tournament official will be scored a Zero.

During tournament play the following will apply to spectators & bowlers:

- No coaching into the settee area, no cell phones, no hats, no foul or abusive language. Only bowlers and workers allowed in the settee area.
