TOURNAMENT RULES:

1. The tournament is open to all USBC Certified bowlers.
2. The entry fee is \$21.00, with the cost of bowling \$5.00, \$1.00 for expenses, and \$15.00 for scholarship prizes.
3. \$2400 in scholarships will be awarded as follows:
(Based on 100 entries. [100/100]
Both Boys and Girls will have separate Divisions.
1st Place - \$500.00 2nd Place - \$250.00 3rd Place - \$200.00
4th Place - \$150.00 5th Place - \$100.00
Plus 2 \$25.00 scholarships will be awarded to both boys and girls divisions for the highest scratch series and high handicap game of the tournament, provided they did not qualify for any other scholarship.
100% of prize money returned to the SMART program acct #8716
4. Scholarships awarded on a ratio of 1 to 8.
5. The format will be three games bowled on one pair of lanes.
6. All bowlers will use their highest 2008-2009 book average, based on a minimum of 15 games. If no book average is available, they shall use their current average as of January 1st, 2010. Those bowlers not having 15 games as of that date, will use their average as of the date 15 games are obtained. That date must be prior to the first date of an individual's competition. All others will bowl scratch. **10 Pin rule Will Be In Effect.** If a bowlers' average is 10 pins or higher then the previous season's average, as of January 1st, 2010, the bowler must use their highest current league average. **Failure to give correct average could result in a disqualification and loss of any scholarship won. COACHES SHOULD BE SURE THAT IF A BOWLER COMPETES IN MORE THAN ONE LEAGUE, INCLUDING TRAVELING LEAGUES, THE HIGHEST AVERAGE IS USED!**
7. Handicap, in its respective division, will be 90% of 200.
8. Bowlers will compete in two different divisions (boys and girls) **Bowlers may enter the tournament up to three times, but a bowler may only win one scholarship.**
9. Bowlers should check-in at least 30 minutes prior to their scheduled bowling shift. Bowlers will receive a zero for any frames missed.
10. In case of a tie, the cash prizes for the positions affected are to be equally divided.
