All bowlers must have a verifiable USBC certified average. Please bring proof of final 2010-11 and current 2011-12 USBC certified averages. Bowlers that were USBC certified in 2010-11, but are not USBC certified in 2011-12 must pay a \$5.00 USBC fee.

- The tournament features seven divisions:
- Youth / Parent - Youth / Adult - Teen / Parent - Teen / Adult
- Youth / Youth** - Teen / Teen** - Youth / Teen**
** NEW THIS YEAR ** These three divisions are for any two USBC certified youth bowlers
- The ratio of advancement from the house level to the state finals is 1:4.
- The state finals are May 12-13 and 19-20, 2012 at McPetes in Big Lake, MN (Big Lake is 40 miles northwest of downtown Minneapolis).
- **Over the past five years, more than \$23,500 in scholarships and awards have been awarded at the Minnesota State Finals.**
- The top two teams at the state finals in the Youth / Parent and Teen / Parent divisions will advance to the International Finals in Jupiter, Florida (July 26 – 28, 2012).
- **Multiple-participation is allowed at the house and state level.** A team of the same two individuals can only advance to the state finals one time. However, a bowler could potentially advance to the state finals as many as twelve times if that person has twelve different partners (i.e. father, mother, grandpa, grandma, friend, neighbor, etc.)
- The cost to bowl at the house level is \$30.00 per team (\$18.00 for lineage and \$12.00 for the state and international participation fee). All teams that advance to the state finals will pay an additional \$18.00 to cover the cost of lineage at the state finals.
- Handicap for this tournament is 100% of the difference between a team's averages added together and 440. See the official rules for details on averages and handicaps.
